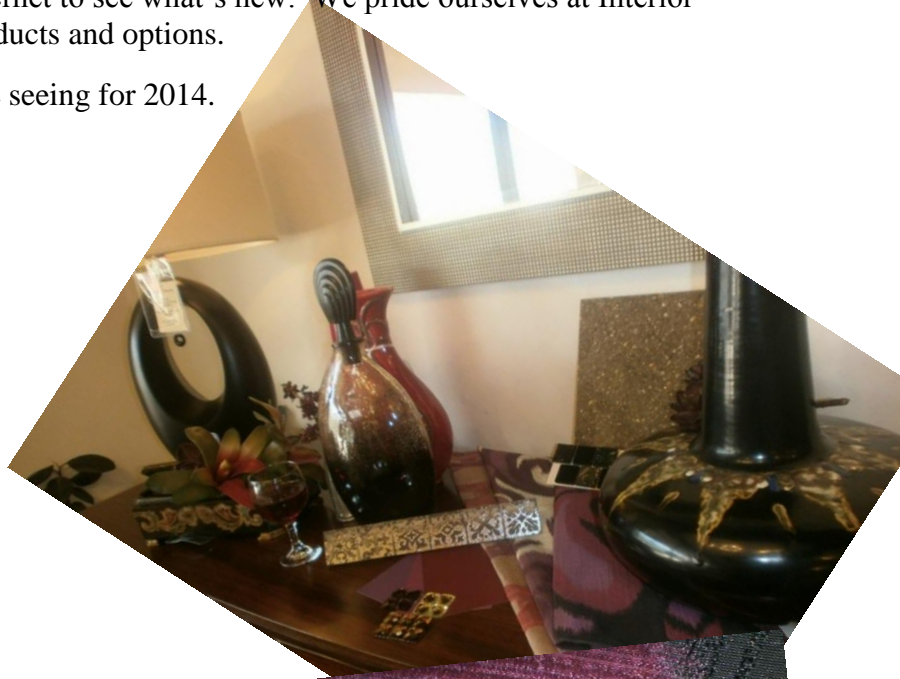
The theme of these colors provides an opportunity for a dark rich accent.

We have arranged a special exhibit of the art of Tucson's own Diana Madaras at our showroom.

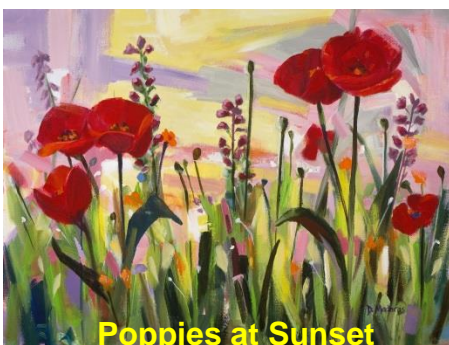

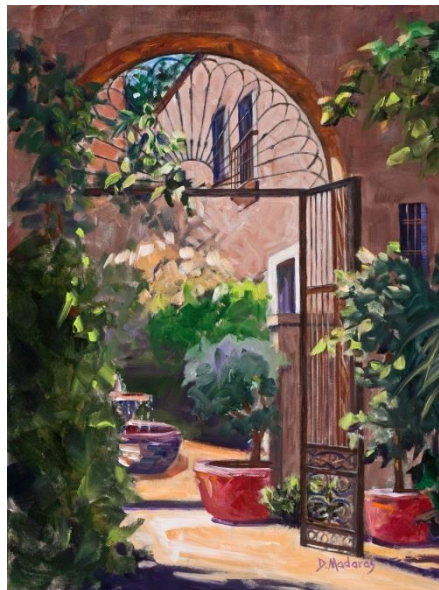
