Design Center

After selecting their model and the modifications they wanted, then came the daunting task of selecting the multitude of finishes.


She didn't have enough shelf space, so we had two more shelves made and shipped to them.



In the kitchen nook we replaced the builder grade light with one that better matched the look and feel desired. A custom painted hutch added extra storage. Custom Roman Shades completed this nook.

The 17 foot high ceiling in the great room, which featured a massive stone fireplace, required an equally massive piece of furniture to balance the room. We accomplished this with a custom entertainment system that is 12 feet wide by 11 feet tall. We mixed some of their existing furniture with new pieces to maintain the Mediterranean look and feel.







For the Man Cave we had a custom bar and electronics cabinet made. We made the bar in a reverse 'S' shape to give it stability without being attached to the wall or floor. The 3-types of reclaimed wood in this unique electronics cabinet is stunning. The horizontal stripe effect of the electronics cabinet compliments the vertical stripe of the bar.
