The hand painted sink bowl was the starting point, complimented by the sculpted mirror and the hand painted mural around the wall (reflected in the mirror).




#### Work Done While They Are Gone

We are so glad we found Betty and Interior Expressions. They have made the process of renovating our ultimate retirement home so easy. I can't imagine how difficult it would be without them.



- Three presidents died on July 4<sup>th</sup> Rivals John Adams & Thomas Jefferson both died on the same day in 1836. James Monroe in 1831.
- Only two people signed the Declaration of Independence on July 4<sup>th</sup>. Most signed on August 2, 1776.
- Ben Franklin was the oldest signatory to the Declaration of Independence, at age 70. The youngest was Edward Rutledge, age 26, who later became the governor of South Carolina.
- Pennsylvania had the most delegates sign. There were nine.
- In January 1777, Thomas McKean was the last to sign the Declaration of Independence. He later became the governor of Pennsylvania.
- Denmark, Norway, Sweden and England also celebrate the 4<sup>th</sup> of July.
- Dwight D. Eisenhower was famous for playing golf every 4<sup>th</sup> of July.
- Jackie Kennedy wore a bejeweled American Flag in her lapel on every 4<sup>th</sup> of July.
- The 4<sup>th</sup> of July became an unpaid federal holiday in 1870, and a paid federal holiday in 1938.
- The first public reading of the Declaration of Independence happened on July 8, 1776. Actually, the Liberty Bell rang out from Independence Hall to summon the crowd.
