

Remake Our Home's Master Bath

Now that Cheri and Brian had moved full-time to Tucson, they wanted to update their home, which had been normally rented during the winter months.

We started with the Master Bath. We didn't change the foot-print, but replaced everything in the Master Bath.



Master Bath Remake

- New Flooring with Heat Mat under tile flooring
- Replace Tub with free-standing tub
- New Cabinets with Tower on counter for added storage to get clutter off the counter
- New Quartz Counters
 - Note the small jut-out of counters and cabinets at tower to give a custom touch
- New light fixtures, including the chandelier over the tub
- New mirrors, with wall mounted make-up mirror
- "Cat shelf" at bottom of window for their cat who likes to look out the window
- New window treatment & window
- New closet doors with mirrors
- Added barn-door from Master Bedroom for added privacy (vs. previous curtain)
- New Shower tile, fixtures and frosted glass door







We couldn't make the shower larger due to a closet and a bedroom on either side.

We created a shower that looks and feels larger with the horizontal tile layout from ceiling to floor, including tiling the ceiling.
