Suzette & Chuck had a structurally sound home, in a great location, with a great view.


Their kids were grown and on their own, and the home they built to raise their kids in was a bit dated and didn't provide the open floor plan so cherished today.

What helped us and our contractor get this project accomplished in fairly short order is that Suzette & Chuck moved out. This turned a 3-5 month project into a short two months.






island. As you can see, we also brightened the kitchen with the lighter cabinets and counters as well as enhanced lighting.

The house had a post-tension slab foundation, so it took some delicate and precise jack-hammering for the water, sewer and electrical in the island.



UPDATED MASTER BATH

To update the Master Bath we...

- Eliminated the never used tub
- Used the tub space to create a spacious shower
- New cabinets, counters, mirrors, lighting, sinks, plumbing fixtures
- Extended the shower wall tile to the ceiling to create the feeling of added height in the room
- Eliminated the shutters on the windows above the old tub
- Added a 'rain-head' shower head the owners wanted after experiencing the same in a hotel
- The shower valves are inside the shower (behind the towels in the picture above), so they can turn on the shower without getting wet.

Betty and her team were outstanding to work with. They helped us fulfill our vision and worked with us every step of the way. We couldn't be happier. We just love our new space. The project involved a complete remodel of the entire house: new kitchen, new master bath, new guest bath, new flooring and light fixtures.

Updated Fireplace

We took out the old fireplace and mantel and replaced them with a gas log, new firebox, new mantel and hearth with a mosaic tile surround to make it the focal point of the room.







New Craftsman Front Door

Our contractor mimicked the brick headers on the exterior of the windows above the new entry door to make it look like it was original to the home.

New Guest Bath

Nearly everything is new in the Guest Bath, but the tub. We re-glazed the old tub to save \$. We also used the same engineered wood flooring that is in the rest of the house.
